**SUBJECT: Change to FORSCOM Regulation 385-1, Use of Helmets While
Operating Army Tactical Vehicles**

Effective immediately, FORSCOM Regulation 385-1, Forces Command Safety Program, is changed as follows: Add new paragraph. Para 5-7d. Head protection (kevlar helmet, CVC or flight helmet as appropriate) will be worn by all personnel operating or riding as a passenger in Army tactical vehicles in the field. Exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Commanding General, U.S. Army Forces Command.
